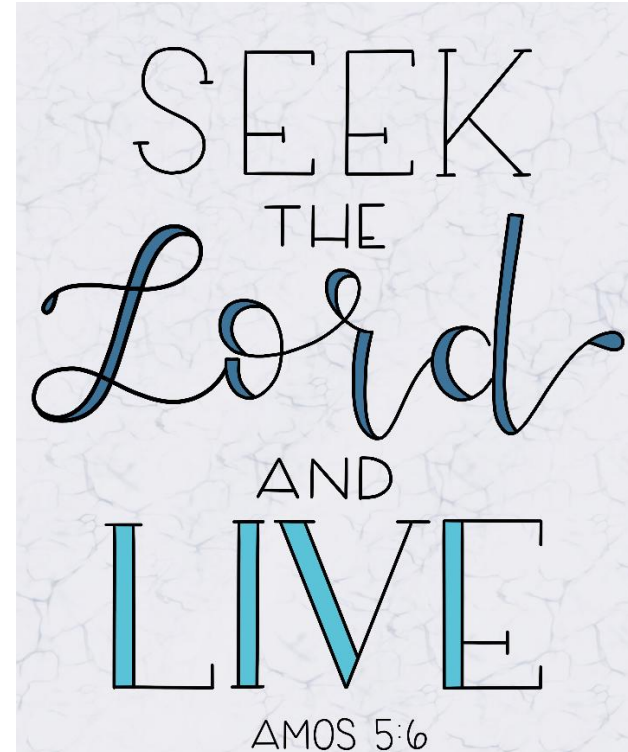
Announcements
