Call to Worship

Renew in us a love for kindness. And draw us ever closer to walking humbly in your way.

Through Jesus Christ, in whom your mercy is made flesh, we pray. Amen.

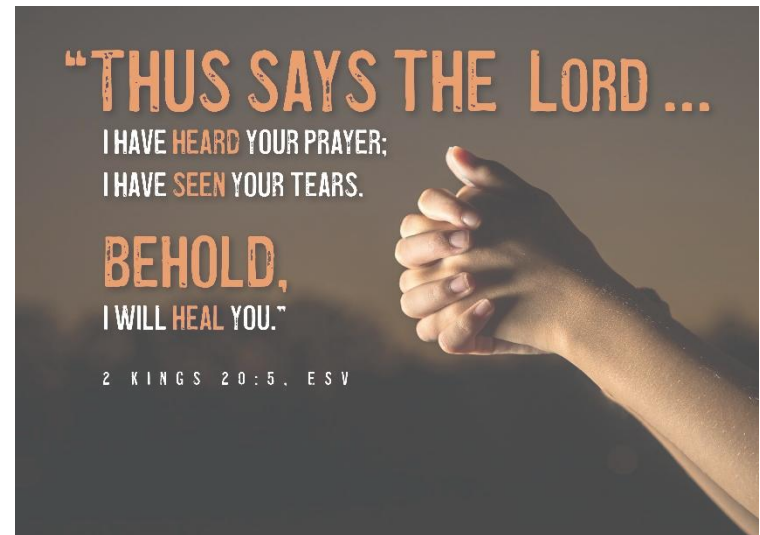
