***Responsive Call to Worship** (Based on Jeremiah 31:31-34)

Leader: The days are surely coming, says the Lord —

People: We gather in hope, for God is faithful to every promise.

Leader: God declares: I will make a new covenant with my people — not like the covenant written on tablets of stone, but written on the heart.

People: Write your law upon our hearts, O Lord. Make us your people.

Leader: I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

People: We are yours, Lord — wholly and completely yours.

Leader: No longer shall we teach one another, saying, "Know the Lord," for all shall know me, from the least to the greatest.

People: Open our eyes to see you. Open our ears to hear you. Open our hearts to know you.

Leader: For God declares: I will forgive their iniquity, and remember their sin no more.

People: Thanks be to God, whose mercy is new every morning!

All: We worship the God of the new covenant —the God who pursues us, forgives us, and writes love upon the tablets of our hearts. Come, let us worship the Lord!

***Call to Confession**

***Prayer of Confession** (based on Jeremiah 1)

Gracious and Holy God, You knew us before you formed us in the womb. You set us apart and called us by name —yet we confess that we have not lived as your people.

Like Jeremiah, we have said, "I do not know how to speak." We have hidden behind our inadequacy, our fear of what others might think, our reluctance to speak your truth in a world that does not always want to hear it.

Forgive us, Lord, for the words we have left unspoken —the comfort we withheld from the grieving, the justice we failed to proclaim for the vulnerable, the good news we kept to ourselves out of timidity or shame.

Forgive us, too, for the times we have spoken without listening first for your voice — rushing ahead with our own words and agendas, rather than waiting for you to touch our lips and fill our mouths with what you would have us say.

You have promised to be with us, to deliver us, to reach out your hand and sustain us. Yet we confess that we have not trusted that promise. We have been afraid, and we have turned away.

Have mercy on us, O Lord. Restore in us the courage of our calling. Remind us again that you have equipped us for every good work to which you have called us.

We receive your forgiveness with grateful hearts, and we ask that you send us out —as you sent Jeremiah —to speak, to serve, and to trust that you are with us wherever you send us.

Through Jesus Christ, in whom all your promises are Yes and Amen. Amen.
